



Knockadoon Youth Week Admission Policy 2025

Mission Statement

The purpose of the KYW is to provide a safe place where young people can come together to enjoy themselves and relax in the company of their peers. It offers young people a chance of a safe holiday away from their normal lives in which development as a human being and growth of their Catholic faith is the central mission of the week.

1. Returning Campers Priority Enrollment

Due to limited resources and high demand for Knockadoon Youth Week 2025, we will be offering early access to campers who successfully registered and attended Knockadoon Youth Week 2024 (In accordance with our records). Parents of eligible returning campers will receive an email containing a registration form. This form is intended solely for the recipient and is **strictly prohibited** from being shared with others. The date and time for the start of priority enrollment will be announced through our social media channels at a later date.

2. Early Access Limitations

While priority is given to returning campers, the number of spaces available during this early enrollment period is capped. Submission is based on a first-come, first-served basis. Submissions from campers who did not attend KYW 2024 will be removed and notified via email. These campers can avail of the spaces on offer during the public release.

3. Open Enrollment for New Campers

Following the early access phase, a separate date will be announced for general enrollment. General enrollment application forms will be published on our website as normal, and this date will be well publicised on our social media channels. We encourage those interested to apply during this public release. Waiting lists will be made available during the public release process.

4. Limited Resources

Knockadoon Youth Week is run entirely by a team of dedicated volunteers, and our resources are limited. We ask for your understanding and patience in this process. Please note that we are unable to facilitate swaps between weeks. Additionally, we are committed to maintaining a respectful environment and will not respond to communications containing abusive or harmful material.

5. Reservation of Rights

Knockadoon Youth Week reserves the right to refuse any application at our discretion. Our decision-making process considers various factors, including the best interests of the camp community and operational constraints.



6. Compliance

Failure to comply with this policy, including the *unauthorized sharing of registration forms*, may result in disqualification from enrollment opportunities.
